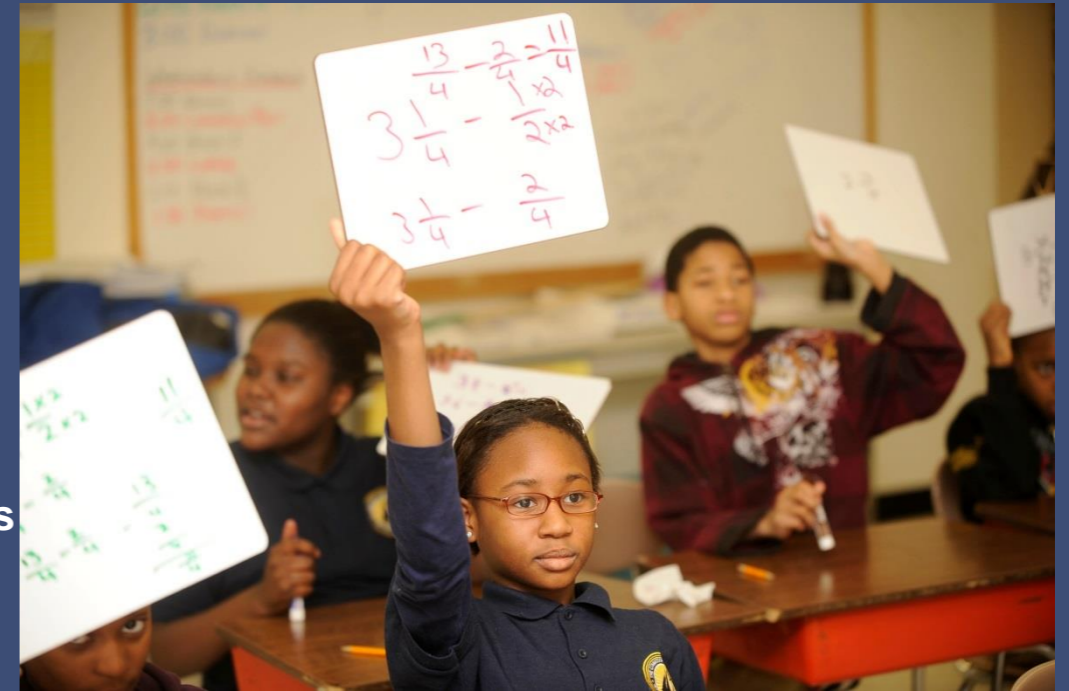
Inspiration: Our motto is “learning by doing,” and we bring a hands-on, experiential education approach to everything we do.
