The Connection Community Consultants Program connects students from the JHU Schools of Public Health, Nursing, and Medicine with each other and with Baltimore community-based organizations (CBOs) through **short-term** projects, lasting about 6 to 8 weeks. Consultants typically volunteer 3 to 4 hours per week.

- Gain exposure to the world of non-profit organizations
- Learn and apply **practical public health skills** such as:
 - Strategic consulting & procedure writing
 - Fundraising strategy, grant writing & research
